CALL TO ORDER – MAYOR AND COUNCIL MEETING

The Honorable Mayor Martin called to order the Special Mayor and Council meeting at 7:10 pm. Those in attendance were Council Members Barrett, Graham, and Parets. Also in attendance were City Solicitor Losco and Interim City Manager Walls.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The Honorable Mayor Martin called for a moment of reflection and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

OLD BUSINESS

A discussion occurred regarding taking a vote on the disposition of the jitney. It was determined that the agenda did not list any old or new business; therefore, no action could be taken at this meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

City Manager Walls asked the Mayor and members of the Council to complete W-4 Forms so that they could be paid for the period from July 1, 2010 through the present time. She clarified that the resolution that was passed previously stated that the Mayor and Council would waive payment for the pay period of July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010. Discussion followed. Council said they would discuss this at the next meeting as it was not on the agenda.

CITY MANAGER CANDIDATE INTERVIEW

The Honorable Mayor Martin stated that the purpose of the meeting was for the Mayor and Council to interview the candidate for the position of City Manager, Joseph Mangini. Mr. Mangini introduced himself and gave a brief overview of his history and qualifications.

RECESS TO EXECUTIVE SESSION

Mayor Martin said he would like to recess the regular meeting and go into Executive Session in order to conduct the interview. Council Member Graham made a motion to go into executive session. Council Member Parets seconded the motion. A vote was taken, all ayes, motion carried. Meeting recessed at 7:22 pm.

RECONVENE MAYOR AND COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING

Mayor Martin reconvened the public portion of the Special Mayor and Council meeting at 8:52. Council Member Parets made a motion that the Mayor and Council, subject to the signing of an agreement letter with the City, herewith names Mr. Joseph A. Mangini, Jr., the new City Manager of the City of Delaware City, his term to begin based on the letter of agreement, at a salary of \$55,000 plus standard benefits. Council Member Barrett seconded the motion. Council commented that they found Mr. Mangini to be the kind of person to fill this job and do it very well. They have a lot of confidence that this will happen. A roll call vote was taken, all ayes, motion carried.

ADJOURNMENT

Council Member Barrett made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Council Member Parets seconded the motion. A vote was taken, all ayes, motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 8:58 pm.
