The City took part in the National Flood Insurance Program's (NFIP) Community Ratings System (CRS). The floodplain management activities implemented by our Town has qualified our residents to receive a 10% discount on their flood insurance. FEMA will automatically reduce all Delaware City residents' flood insurance by 10%, you do not have to take any action.
