CANAL PROMENADE EXTENSION PROJECT

Phase IV of the Canal Promenade is underway with completion projected by the end of June. The project will pick up the brick walkway from the Pump House at the bottom of Hamilton Street, all the way along Canal Street, to Fifth Street. The capital improvement is entirely funded with a grant award of \$500,000.00 from the Delaware Land and Water Conservation Trust Fund. The walkway will meet with the Connector Project which starts behind the Community Center ball field. The Branch Canal Connector is funded with over 1 million dollars from DTF, Environmental Penalty funds, and settlement funds. It is in the design phase with construction scheduled to begin in the fall of 2011. It will include a bicycle and pedestrian walkway that continues across Route 9, behind Kathy's Crab House, through the natural area along the edge of the Canal. There is an artist's rendering of the project at Town Hall that shows how it will tie in with the proposed Greenway Trail that will allow visitors to walk and bike all the way from Delaware City to Chesapeake City.

On other grant news, Delaware City received a Federal Energy Efficiency Community Block Grant to make critical upgrades to the Community Center/Library. The State of Delaware chose the Delaware City Community Center as the site to launch the statewide program, with a ceremony on February 25, 2011.
