AT THE NOVEMBER 21, 2011 MAYOR AND COUNCIL MEETING, THE COUNCIL VOTED TO CHANGE THE RECYCLING PICK UP TO EVERY OTHER WEEK. THE CHANGE IS STILL IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE STATE'S NEW RECYCLING LAW. THE STATE LAW REQUIRES EVERY OTHER WEEK RECYCLING.

THE NEW BI-WEEKLY RECYCLING PICK-UP WILL BEGIN WITH MONDAY, DECEMBER 5, 2011. YOUR RECYCLING WILL CONTINUE TO BE PICKED UP ON MONDAYS. THE DATES FOR PICK-UP ARE AS FOLLOWS:

STREETLIGHT OUTAGES

If you discover a streetlight that is out, please report the outage to Delmarva Power by calling 1-800-375-7117 press 4 and then press 0. You will need to have the location of where the outage is. You will also need the pole number that is on the light pole that is out. You can find this number by looking on the pole where there is usually a plate with a set of numbers one on top of the other. You will need these two numbers. You will also need the address of the nearest residence to the pole.
