The Delaware City Historic Preservation (HPC) met in a publicly noticed meeting on October 7, 2014 to consider your application for renovations to your property at 201 Jefferson Street in Delaware City. These renovations include: Replace porch column with matching wood column if available. If not available will replace with new fiberglass column that is an exact replica of the historic structure.

The HPC reviewed the proposal with consideration of the factors required under Section 49-6a. *Alterations*, the Secretary of the Interior's Standards, and the intent of review process under Section 49-1. The Commission approved the renovations as presented.

Because the application is for alterations to a building within the historic district but outside of the C-1 Central Commercial zone, the recommendations of the Commission are advisory.
