Dear Jack & Billie Taylor:

The Delaware City Historic Preservation (HPC) met in a publicly noticed meeting on September 1, 2015 to consider your application for renovations to your property at 201 Adams Street in Delaware City. These renovations include:

The installation of shutters to the exterior windows in the same style that was found in decayed condition in the house.

1. First floor to be 2 panel raised panel shutters. Second and third floors to be louvered Shutters
2. The material to be installed and approved is Mid-America vinyl shutters with vinyl shutter dogs. Burgundy color was chosen at the time by Billie Taylor.

The HPC reviewed the proposal with consideration of the factors required under Section 49-6a. *Alterations*, the Secretary of the Interior's Standards, and the intent of review process under Section 49-1.

It is noted that there was some discussion on using wooden shutters to maintain the historic integrity of the home due to its age and historic significance. The Commission approved the renovations as presented.

Because the application is for alterations to a building within the historic district but outside of the C-1 Central Commercial zone, the recommendations of the Commission are advisory.
