## **NEW RECYCLING PROCEDURES COMING TO DELAWARE CITY FOR ALL RESIDENTS**

On June 8, 2010, Delaware State Senate Bill 234 was signed into law and requires that Delaware City provide curbside recycling collection to **ALL** residents. The State of Delaware, and Delaware City, know the importance of reducing the amount of solid waste disposal at the landfills and recovering usable materials from solid waste so as to minimize the environmental impact.

It is in the public's best interest for the State to develop a comprehensive statewide system of recycling and resource recovery which maximizes the amount of solid waste materials which can be recovered, reused, or converted to beneficial use.

The law mandates that Delaware City provide both a recycling container and single stream curbside recycling services. Single stream means that all recycling materials: newspaper; clear, green, brown glass; steel and aluminum cans; and corrugated boxes, can be placed into a single container. Since 2002, Delaware City has provided **free** curbside recycling service to interested residents. The difference is now the law requires Delaware City to deliver a recycling cart to **ALL** single-family residential customers for the purpose of collecting recyclables. The purpose is to encourage all residents to recycle and Delaware City is pleased to do our part to have a positive impact on our environment.
