Dear Mr. & Mrs. Costango:

The Delaware City Historic Preservation Commission (HPC) met in a publicly noticed meeting on November 15, 2011 to consider your application to install a new fence. Zoning Code Section 46-64(k) requires review and approval of fences by the HPC in the historic district.

The fence section begins at the rear-most wall of your dwelling and runs parallel to Third Street, terminating at the rear of your property. The fence is vinyl and meets height requirements and setbacks for the installation location. Although the material does not meet the Commission's standards, it was determined pursuant to the Zoning Code §49-6 (a.)(2.)(b.), compliance with the Commission's recommendation is voluntary.

The HPC approved installation of your fence. Thank you for your cooperation with the Historic Preservation Commission.
