Significant Events

- Officer Earl McCloskey has accepted a position as Executive Director at DELJIS (Delaware Justice Information System). He will start his new position on February 1, 2018.
- On December 22, 2017 a New Castle County Grand Jury handed down an indictment for Kevin J. Magaw. Mr. Magaw was indicted on two counts of unlawful sexual contact of a child under the age of 13 and one count of offensive touching. Mr. Magaw is currently a fugitive and we are seeking his whereabouts. The indictment authorizes us to extradite Mr. Magaw from anywhere.
- The Delaware City Police Department has received funding from the Delaware Office of Highway Safety for overtime for violations of the occupant restraint law (seatbelts) and speed enforcement. This program will begin on January 23<sup>rd</sup> and end on February 26<sup>th</sup>.
