**ORDINANCE 18-0521-01
TO AMEND CITY CODE REGARDING
TO AMEND SECTION 23-14(A) OF THE DELAWARE CITY CODE**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article V, Section 5-02(A) of The City of Delaware City Charter ("Charter"), and pursuant to the "Powers of the City," outlined in Article II, § 2-1 of the Charter, the Mayor and the Council of The City of Delaware City ("City Council") possess the authority to adopt, amend, modify, or repeal The City of Delaware City Code ("Code"); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council desire to amend Chapter 23, Section 14A of the Code to correct a numbering error.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Mayor and City Council believe this ordinance is in the best interest of the City and is necessary to enhance the health, safety, and welfare of the City of Delaware City, and as such, the Mayor and the City Council of The City of Delaware City hereby ordain and adopt the following Code changes and revisions:


Section 1. Amend Section 23-14A by deleting the strikethrough language and by adding the underlined language below:

A. Chapter 1 "Scope and Administration" is amended by deleting the chapter in its entirety and substituting the following "Chapter 532 of the Code of City of Delaware City – Department of Building Inspection and Code Enforcement; Permits and Approvals."

Section 2. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable. If any provisions of this Ordinance are found by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or void, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall remain valid, unless the court finds that the valid provisions of this Ordinance are so essentially and inseparably connected with, and so dependent upon, the unconstitutional or void provision that it cannot be presumed that City Council would have enacted the remaining valid provisions without the unconstitutional or void provision; or unless the court finds that the remaining valid provisions, standing alone, are incomplete and incapable of being executed in accordance with City Council's intent.


