Incident Information

- On Wednesday, July 1st, DCPD investigated a report of three individuals threatening a 27-year-old victim with a firearm. The incident occurred in the Delaware City Mobile Home Park and the suspects fled prior to the officer's arrival. At least one of the suspects have been identified and the investigation is continuing.
- On Tuesday, July 14th, DCPD responded to the area of 2nd and Clinton Street in reference to an individual threatening to assault a 39-year-old Delaware City resident. Upon arrival, officers were able to identify the suspect in this incident. He was taken into custody a short time later. It was learned the individual may have suffering from a mental health issue. He was transported to the Christiana Hospital for evaluation.
- On Sunday, July 19th, DCPD officers responded to Crabby Dick's restaurant for a report of a fight involving a knife. Upon arrival officers interviewed the 55-year-old victim, who advised the did not want prosecution in the cause. However, it was learned that a verbal altercation occurred between the victim and a 34-year-old New Castle resident. During the verbal altercation, the suspect pulled a knife from his pocket, cutting himself on the hand. The suspect refused medical treatment and left the area.
