

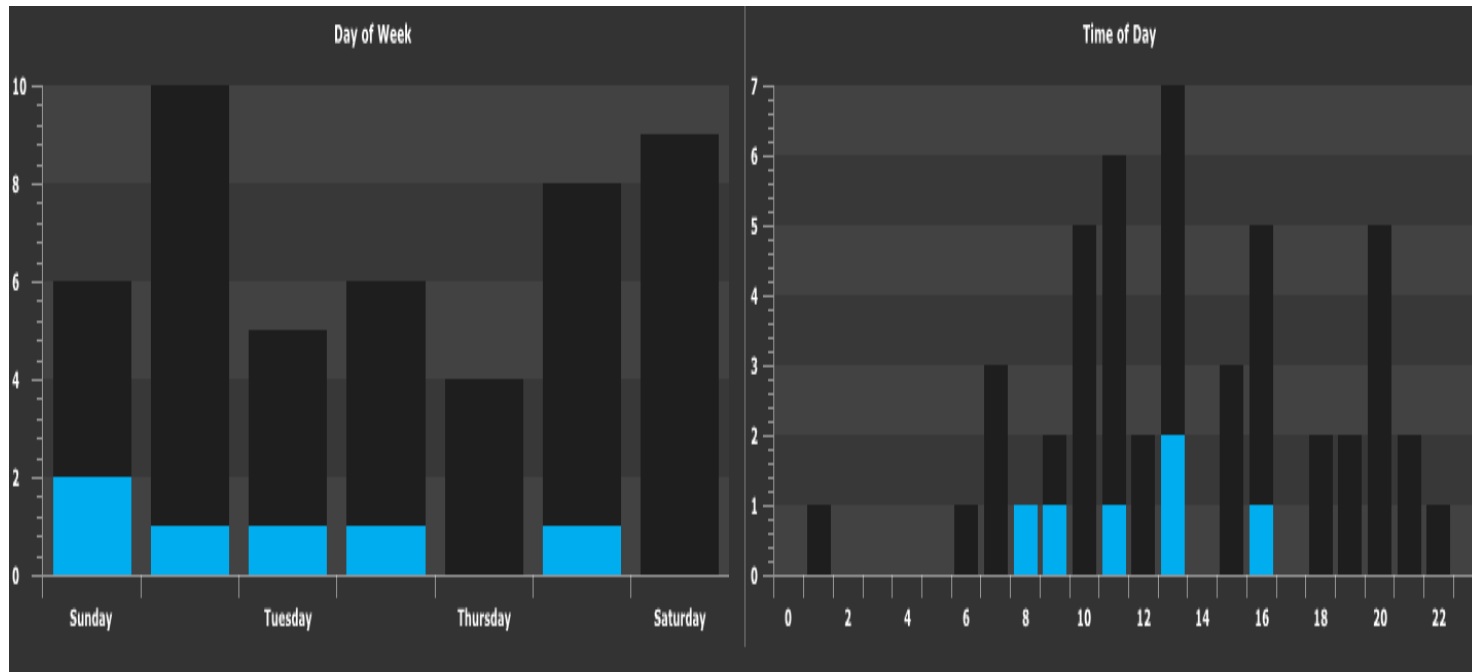

Significant Events:

- 1.** The Police Department handled a total of six(6) graffiti incidents in the City between May 18th and June 1st. All occurred on either the Fifth St. corridor, Washington St. or Clinton St. Immediate steps were taken to have the owners remove and/or cover the graffiti with hope that these crimes did not continue, as well as measures such as overnight patrols in an effort to catch and arrest those responsible. No arrests have been made at this but we are actively pursuing leads. I am also happy to report that no other incidents have occurred since June 1st.
- 2.** The Police Department was awarded funding from the Office of Highway Safety to purchase a solar powered speed sign. This item has a value just over \$3,000 and will assist in vehicular speed management in the City.
