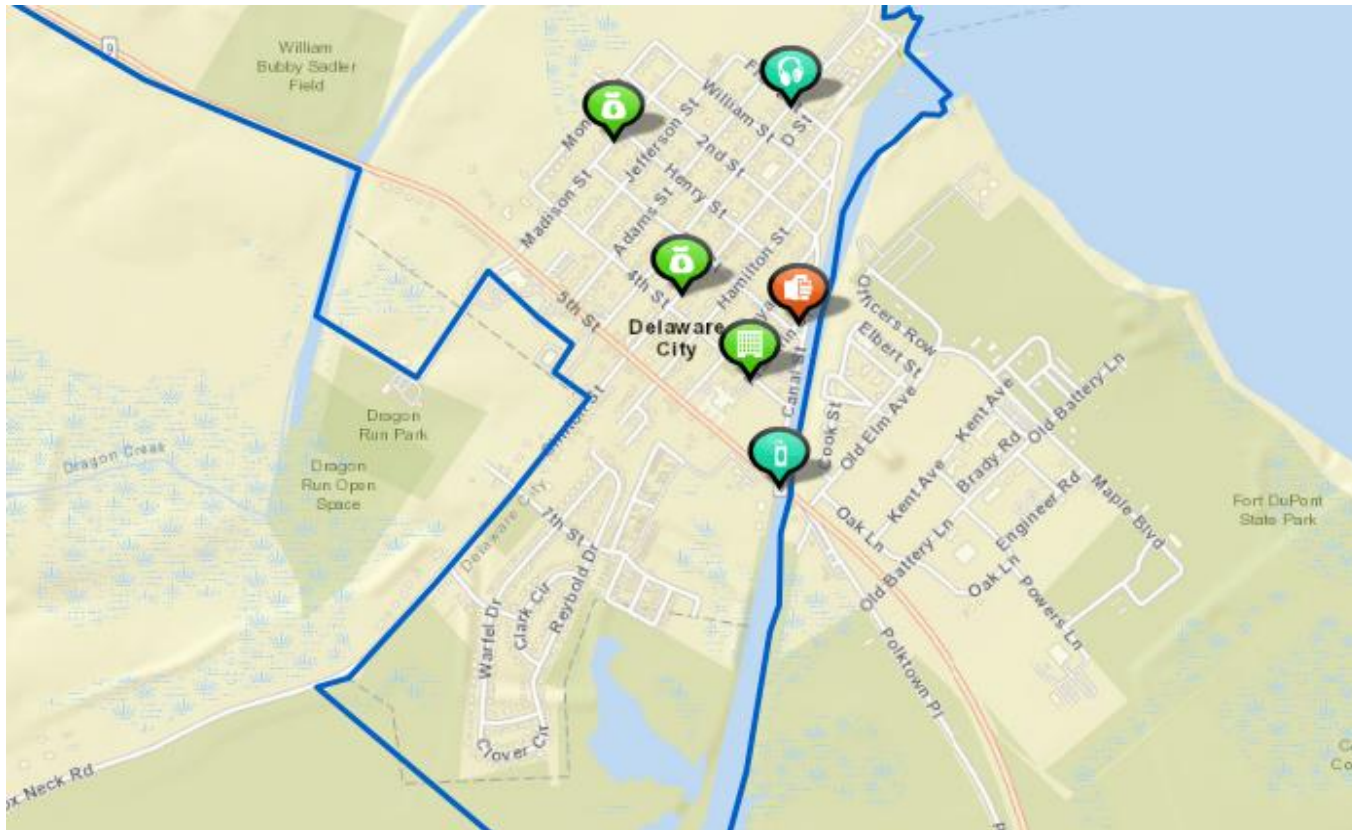


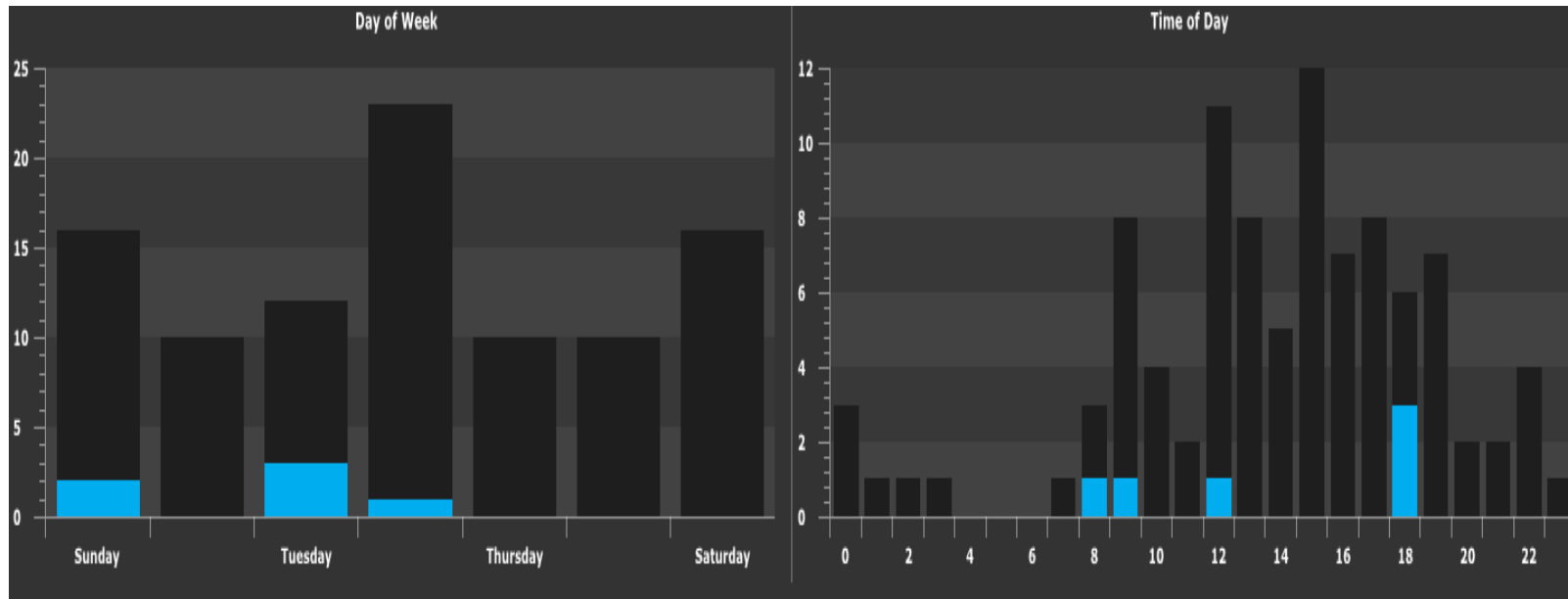

Significant Events:

- 1.** The Police Department only received **two(2)** calls regarding fireworks, one July 3rd and one July 4th. No citations issued. Also, **zero (0)** calls for fireworks handled by the New castle County Police during DCPD off hours. We also had proactive conversations regarding the legality of fireworks in Delaware City, which is believed to have assisted in eliminating potentiall calls for service.
- 2.** The Police Department was awarded grant funding (Byrne) in the amount of \$3,200 to utilize on the purchase of equipment.
- 3.** An agreement was signed with Axon to acquire five (5) upgraded BWC units and a charging dock to replace our older models, **AT NO COST**. We are currently awaiting arrival of these new units for deployment.
